

ABBI Morris Casriel Katz came to St. Paul in September, 1944, and within the brief space of time between then and now has made the present Congregation Sons of Jacob into the fastest growing Orthodox congregation in the Twin Cities.

Rabbi Katz' middle name really should be "Determination." It is almost beyond imagination to think what "might have been" but for the stout heart and never-give-up spirit of our Rabbi.

The difficulties he faced are beyond comprehension. Despite very serious obstacles and opposing forces, he succeeded in making this congregation what it is today.

But, that is water under the bridge. The Sons of Jacob synagogue, as it stands today, speaks for itself and for Rabbi Katz' unselfish and untiring efforts.

Prior to his coming to St. Paul, Rabbi Katz was spiritual leader of the Beth Jacob Congregation of Hamilton, Ont. From December 1939 until he came to St. Paul he was also part-time chaplain in the Canadian Army. He was in charge of the Dutch Jewish personnel at the Princess Juliana Barracks in Guelph, Ont.

He was commissioned with the rank of H/Captain. His duty was to look after the spiritual needs of Jewish personnel in all Canadian Army camps, Royal Canadian Air Force and Royal Air Force stations in the Niagara Peninsula. In Canada he was a member of the national executive of the Canadian Conference of Christians and Jews. He also was a member of the national administrative board of the Canadian Jewish Congress and of the Zionist Organization of Canada.

Rabbi Katz was graduated from the Hebrew Theological College in September, 1932, and received his secular education at Crane college and Lewis Institute in Chicago. He is a student in the Graduate school of the University of Minnesota and has been majoring in philosophy.

In St. Paul he is on the board of directors of



the United Jewish Fund and Council, Bureau of Jewish Education, Jewish Family Service, St. Paul Jewish Council, Jewish Community Center, Zionist Organization of St. Paul and Zionist Organization of the Northwest Region.

He also is a member of the executive board of the Minnesota Department of Jewish War Veterans and of the District No. 4 (Ramsey County) of American Legion of Minnesota. He is chaplain of the Minnesota Department of Jewish War Veterans and also head chaplain of all the American Legion posts in Ramsey County.

Rabbi Katz is president of the Alumni Association of the Hebrew Theological college in Chicago, vice president of the Minnesota Rabbinical Association and a member of the Rabbinical Council of America.

He is a former member of the Board of Directors of the St. Paul Urban league. He has been active for several years on the Citizens committee deciding public school problems. He is often called upon to speak before non-Jewish groups and is active in supporting the program of the St. Paul Round Table of the National Conference of Christians and Jews and of the St. Paul Council of Human Relations. He is an honorary director of the Hebrew Theological College in Chicago.




To all the officers and committeemen and chairmen of the various affairs sponsored by us and to every member, I say thank you for your ardent support.

History of Congregation Sons of Jacob

THE Congregation Sons of Jacob this month is observing its Diamond anniversary.

It has been seventy-five years of glorious expression of Jewish religious life that finds the sons and daughters and grandchildren of the founders observing daily, Sabbath and holiday services in an edifice that is a far cry from the original frame dwelling on Payne Avenue near Seventh Street where services were held as far back as 1869, six years before the group was incorporated into a congregation.

But, the present \$125,000 structure now located at Portland. Avenue and Pascal Street is just the beginning of greater things to come.

As the founders look down upon us from high above they must sing with joy as they see the result of their groundwork blossom into one of the finest and most modern synagogues. If we could talk to them we would tell them

the present plans call for the completion of a building that will exceed a quarter of a million dollars in cost and be second to none as a place for prayer, study and fellowship.

Writing the history of the Sons of Jacob synagogue is a difficult task.

Here and there may be a name or an event omitted. If such be the case it has been done because the data just was not obtainable. Therefore we ask the reader to bear with us in our shortcomings.

We don't mean to be facetious, but we just can't help giving the famous Chicago fire indirect credit in the founding of our synagogue.

When the newly-wed Nathan Blumenthal and his bride of a few weeks were forced to flee from their

burning home in Chicago, they headed for St. Paul.

He was among those who attended Sabbath and holidays services in the Payne Avenue residence. It was not long before he started campaigning for a regular congregation.

One didn't need salesmanship to sell the idea of a permanent synagogue for this city. He was met with enthusiasm wherever or whenever he talked.

Within two years after he had come to St. Paul the group was functioning as an organized congregation for the Sons of Jacob Synagogue.

Incomplete records show us that the plan for the synagogue was launched at a meeting in a private dwelling early in 1871.

Among those who attended this all important meeting were several members of the Coddon family including Samuel Coddon, Mr. Blumenthal, Simon Jacobs, David Goodman, Wolf Goodman, Abraham Kaufman, Nathan B. Cohen, Charles Polski, Moses Calmenson, David Samelson, Raphael Machinsky, Ephraim Skorish, Mayer Rosenholtz, Josha Rosenholtz, Aaron Mark and others, whom the records fail to list.

This was in 1871.

In four short but trying years, March 22, 1875, to be exact, the dream was realized.

A group of Jews met at what is now 252 North Robert Street, and elected officers. Mr. Blumenthal was the first president and the board of trustees were: David Goodman, Wolf Goodman and Abraham Kaufman. Mr. Blumenthal and Mr. David Goodman appeared before a notary public and the first certificate of incorporation was drawn up.

There is a copy available now of a subsequent certificate

filed on June 24, 1881, "to put to rest any question as to the legal incorporation of the said 'The Congregation of the Sons of Jacob' incorporated under their certificate of incorporation dated March 22, 1875".

The officers listed in addition to Mr. Blumenthal as president, are Simon Jacobs, secretary, J. D. Friedman as rabbi; and Nathan B. Cohen, Charles Polski, and Moses Calmenson as trustees.

By this time the Congregation had graduated from the Payne Avenue private residence to the Robert St. residence and was conducting its services in a wooden structure at 16 W. College Avenue.

Within seven years our ever-aspiring forefathers had erected a brick structure,

lovingly known as the "College Avenue Shul." It might be well to state here that Mrs. Isaac Jacobs recalls being married in the newly erected synagogue.

Under the guidance of Aaron Gottstein, who was then the president, the congregation in 1897 printed a copy of the constitution. So that there would be no misunderstanding, it was printed in both Yiddish and English.

The signers of the constitution, in addition to Mr. Gottstein, were L. Steinberg as vice president, Nathan Blumenthal, secretary, and Alex Silver, chairman of the constitution committee.

The membership grew. Each of the incoming set of officers did a magnificent job.

As the city grew so did the Jewish population. Residential and business districts soon blossomed in what in the early

Past Presidents

In listing our past presidents we again regret to say that there are some names missing. Every avenue of possible information was searched, but to get a complete list of men who gave their time and effort to build this congregation has just been impossible.

Available records show these names: Nathan Blumenthal, Aaron Gottstein, Simon Jacobs, Harry Kahn, Isaac Abrahamson, Louis Pavian, Alex Silver, Louis Goldman, Philip Greenberg, Samuel Coddon, Max Grazovsky, Mendel Copilovich, Wolf Resnick, Morris Oglansky, Ben Schmuckler, Morris Kieffer and William Applebaum.

The Rebetzin monomorph

rs. Morris C. Katz was born in Toronto, Ontario, and received her secular and Jewish education there.

She always has taken an active part in the Jewish life of the community she has lived in.

In Toronto she was president of the Council of Jewish Women, junior division, and of Mispah Chapter of Junior Hadassah. In Hamilton, Ontario, she was president of the Sharon Chapter of Hadassah and president of the Council of Hadassah Organizations as well as a member of the National Executive Board of



the Hadassah Organization of Canada.

She started in Hamilton the first five-day-a-week pre-kindergarten for children from three to five years of age. In St. Paul she was in charge of the first successful pre-kindergarten from Oct., 1944, to June, 1946.

She is very active in the Sons of Jacob Sisterhood and acts as its adviser. She has been a member of the board of the St. Paul Chapter of Hadassah and its Child Welfare chairman. She also has been a board member of the St. Paul Chapter of the Council of Jewish Women.

part of the century was termed as the outskirts or swamplands.

No longer was there a center of Jewish population. The Jews moved to the Midway, to Highland Park, to River

Drive, among other sections. Each year the distance between the home and the Sons of Jacob synagogue grew further and further apart.

The need for another synagogue closer to the Midway district soon became apparent. Thus in the summer of 1944 the Hebrew Seminary Congregation was formed with a membership of about 30. Prior to the formation of the latter synagogue, the neighborhood Jews, like their forefathers, conducted services in a pri-

vate residence at 1426 Portland Ave. On the High Holidays the services were held in a public hall on Grand near Cambridge.

When the Hebrew Seminary Congregation was organized the services were then moved to 1464 Summit Ave.

Rabbi Morris Casriel Katz, our present spiritual leader,

assumed his rabbinical duties at the Hebrew Seminary Congregation, Sept. 1, 1944. A Talmud Torah also was started in 1944. It was known as the George Kaplan Hebrew Seminary. Bernard Harris was the teacher-principal.

In the fall of that year, Rabbi Katz and the Rebetzin were instrumental in starting a pre-kindergarten for children from three and a half to five years old.

Mrs. Katz was in charge from November 1944 until June 1946.

It was about that time that negotiations were started for the merger of the Hebrew Seminary Congregation, known by this time as the Beth Gedaliah Congregation, and the "College Ave. Shul".

Past Rabbis and Cantars

Among the Rabbis of the Congregation Sons of Jacob were: Rabbis J. D. Friedman, Simon, Alperstein, Rivkin, Baer "Prager" (Kadad Rabbi) and J. B. Hurwitz.

The Cantors included: Aronson and Eli Kreidberg.

> As usual in such undertakings there was opposition from both institutions. At times the feelings became bitter and personal, but when the heat of the battle had died down the majority of the so-called opposition joined the majority of each congregation and thus the new modern Congregation, Sons of Jacob was born, Nov. 10, 1946.
